

MEMO TO FAMILIES, ESSENTIAL CAREGIVERS Jan 6, 2022

St. Joseph's Long-Term Care in Suspect Outbreak status

This is to advise that Brant County Health Unit has placed St. Joseph's Lifecare Centre in Suspect COVID-19 Outbreak status due to a number of staff-positive results on rapid antigen tests, pending the outcome of PCR test results. At this time, no residents have tested positive for COVID-19.

In consultation with Brant County Health Unit, the following precautionary measures are now in place to reduce the potential for spread:

- essential caregivers will be limited to one visitor at a time. Please make every effort to align your visit to be available to assist your loved one with personal care and meals (in room).
- residents will be placed on tray service vs. communal/cafeteria dining. Those needing assistance, in the absence of an essential caregiver, will continue to receive meals in the dining room.
- the number of residents participating in individual programming activities will be reduced to groups of three.
