

Air Conditioning Disclosure Statement St. Joseph's Long-Term Care Facility

As per the Fixing Long-Term Care Act and Regulations, 2021, Section 271, St. Joseph's Lifecare Centre Brantford (SJLCB) discloses that all long-term care resident rooms have central air conditioning.

The SJLCB facility uses a Trane Automated HVAC system to track all building temperatures in resident rooms and common areas of the long-term care home. All long-term care areas have a thermometer to monitor temperatures throughout the day. All areas are maintained between 22 and 26 degrees Celsius. In the event that any area reaches a temperature outside of the prescribed range, this is immediately reported to the maintenance department which is available during regular hours and after hours for immediate actions.
