Upon completion of the course, learners should be able to: identify pain types/causes of pain, recognize the impact that delirium has on patients and families, recognize difference individuals experiencing normal grief and those at risk of more complicated grief, recall how to prepare individuals and families for the last dats and hours and many more outcomes.
